




Platform Statistics



Facebook, YouTube continue to be the most widely used online platforms among U.S. adults


% of U.S. adults who say they ever use the following online platforms or messaging apps online or on their cellphone










Raeford road, from Skibo road to the Hoke County line are experiencing a power outage, according to a tweet from the Fayetteville Police Department.

(Fayetteville, NC) -- Detectives with the Fayetteville Police Department's Homicide Unit have charged a second suspect in connection with the homicide of Rayd Hezam Ali Al Qadhi, which occurred along the 1500 block of Clinton Road on Wednesday, May 22, 2019.

Detectives obtained warrants charging Rodriquez D. McNeill (B/M, 23 years of age), of the 800 block of Thompson Avenue in Elizabethtown, North Carolina with 1st Degree Murder, Robbery with a Dangerous Weapon, and Conspiracy to Commit Robbery with a Dangerous Weapon.

McNeill is currently being treated at a local medical facility regarding an unrelated injury. McNeill will be transported to the Cumberland County Detention Center upon his release from the medical facility.

There is no additional information to release.

Facebook: Less = More?





- Goal should be no more than three posts a day.
 - Spread out throughout the day, not back to back.
- Facebook algorithms show people what it thinks they want to see.
 - Based on previous engagement from that person.
- If someone is not interacting with your posts and just scrolling by,
 Facebook will start showing fewer of your posts to that person.
- Your goal should also be to have at least one post a day.
 - Maintain your presence.











- Respond to Messages Don't ignore them.

- Set up auto-away.



- Event Reminders






Twitter




- Twitter users are more forgiving with frequent posts.
 - They expect constant engagement.
- The Half-Life of a Tweet is 24 minutes.
 - Within the first half hour, a tweet gets half its interactions.
 - It then starts dying.
- Most brands tweeted an average of 122 times a month in 2017.
 - Most U.S. adult Twitter
 users don't engage much. The median Twitter user posts two tweets a
 month, favorites one tweet a month, follows 89 accounts and has 25
 followers.



Twitter: Tweetdeck



- Free dashboard to assist brands manage twitter.
- Not as complicated as it looks.
- Better notification tracking
- Allows you to monitor columns
 - Can be customized





Instagram



- Best for positive posts
 - Crime posts don't do as well
- Filters matter
- No native scheduling feature
- No native over all analytical feature
 - Analytics available per post
- Younger users typically







Scheduling



- Facebook & Twitter allow you to schedule posts.
- Use scheduling to maintain your presence after hours.
- Be prepared to reschedule the posts if a significant event occurs.








Responsiveness



- Don't ignore comments or messages.
 - You don't have to respond to every comment, but consider engaging.
 - We go through and 'like' comments as an acknowledgement
- Social media cannot go unmonitored.
 - Who is going to monitor it after-hours.


